

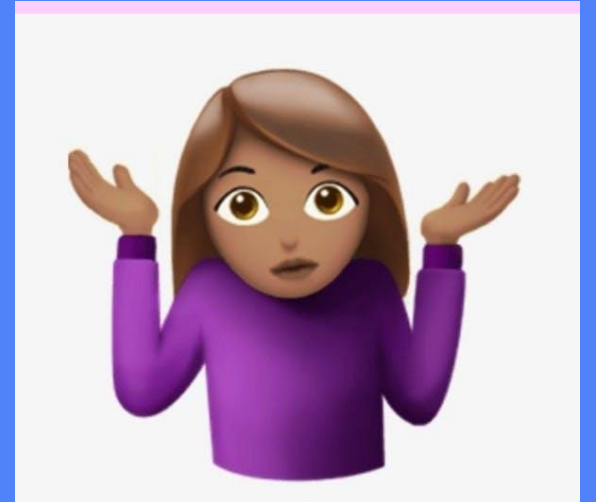

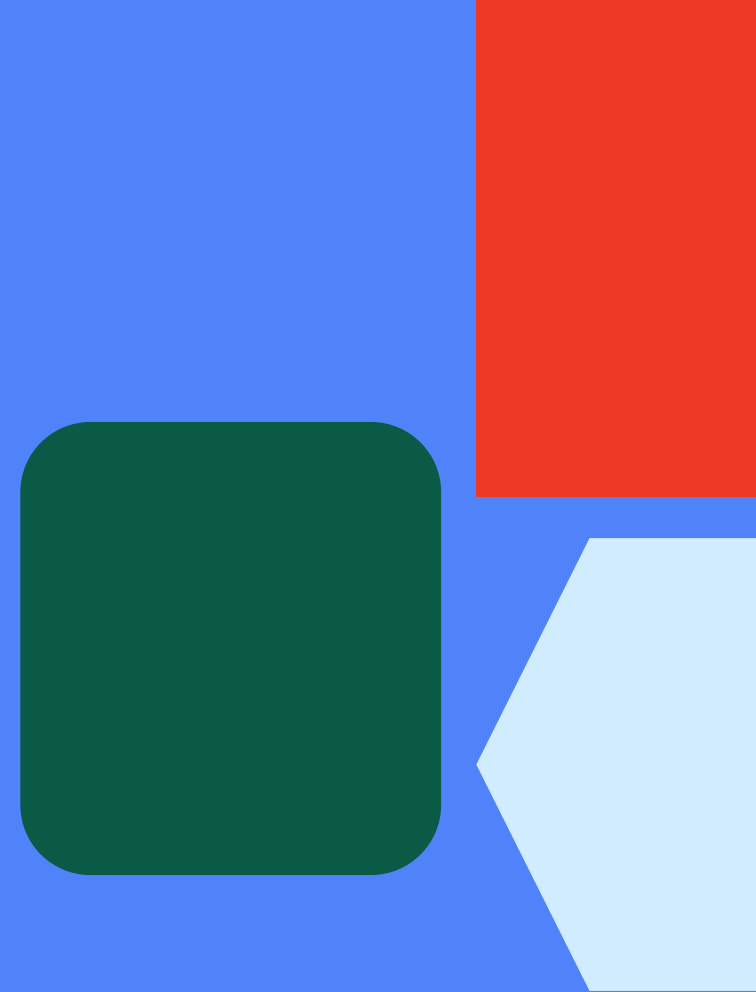

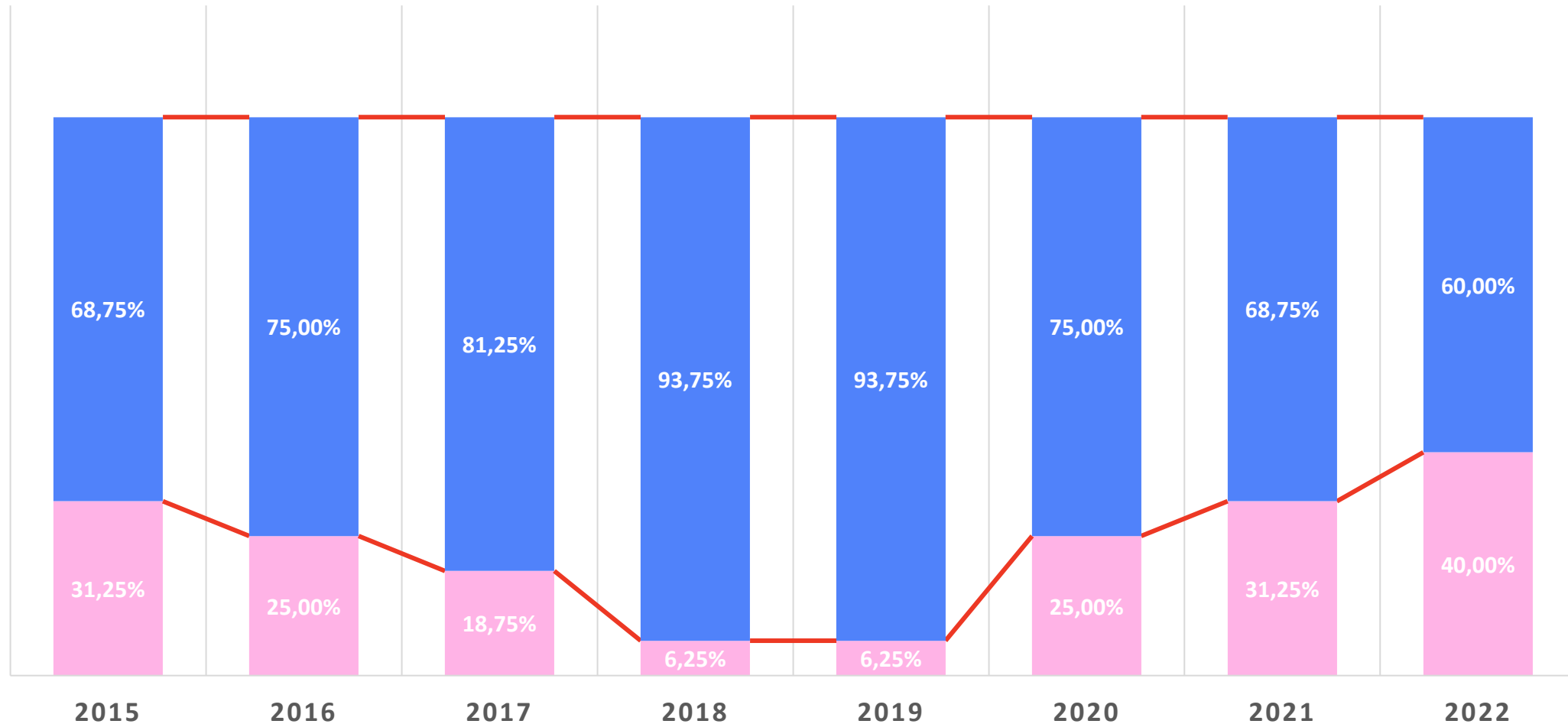

Gender balance evolution within the scientific committee

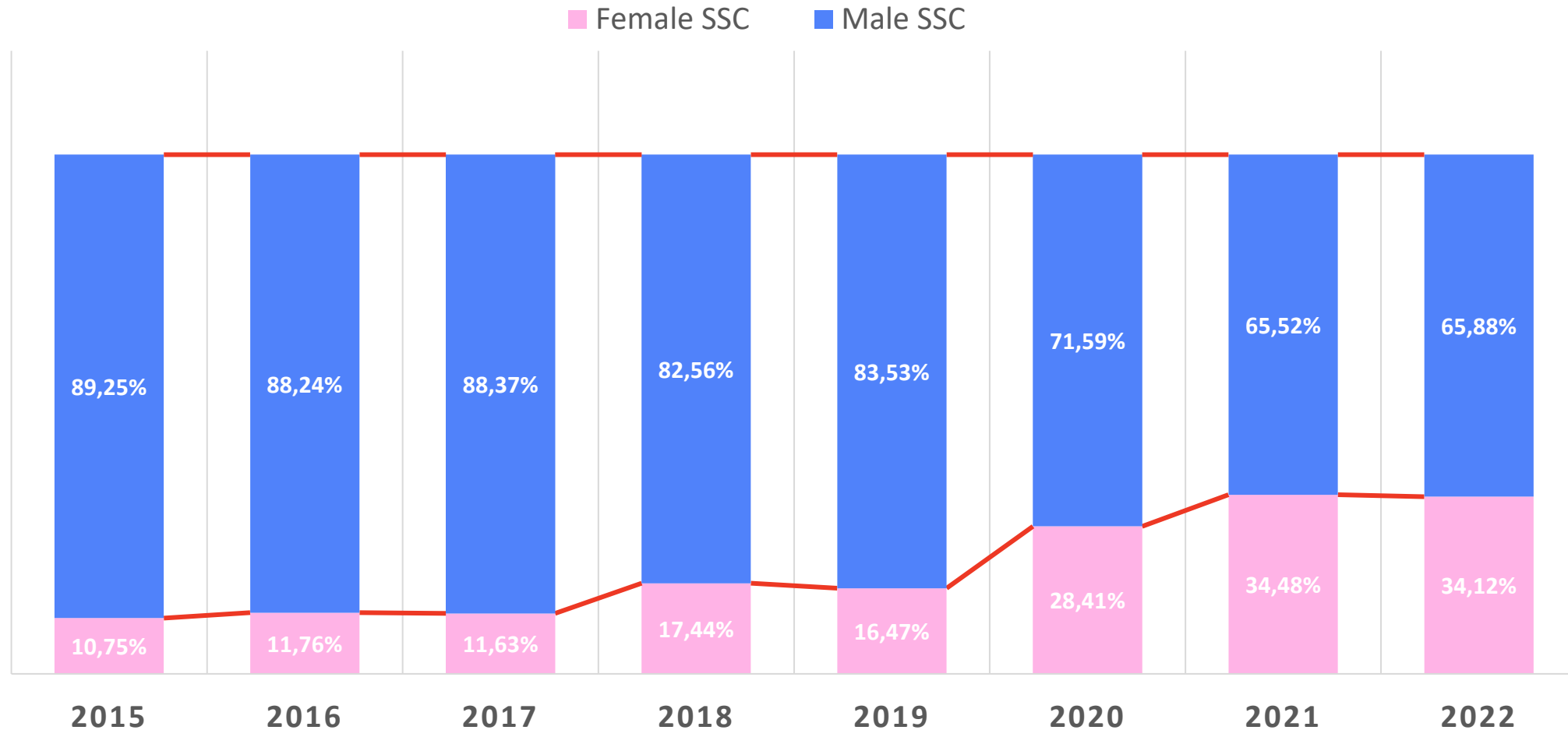

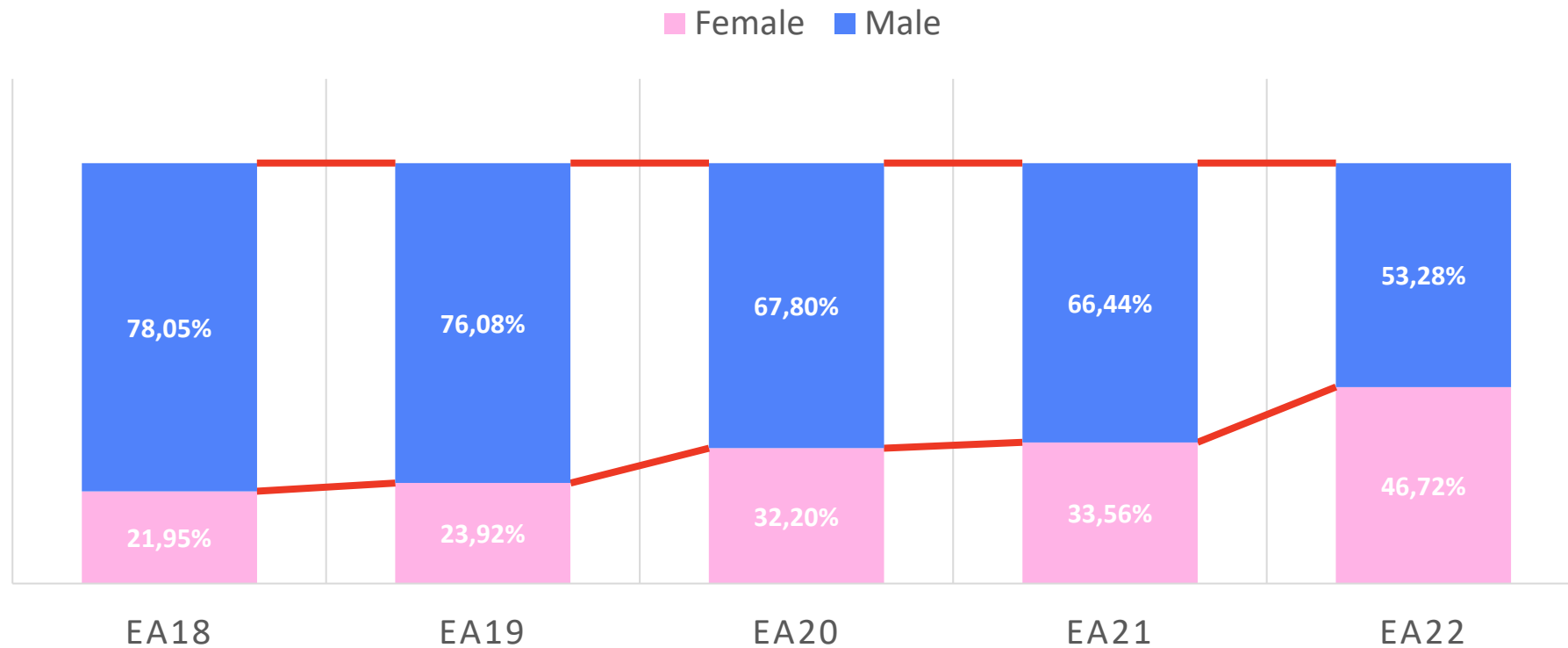

Gender balance among speakers at Euroanaesthesia

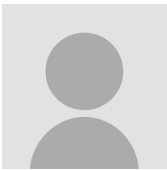
EUROANAESTHESIA GENDER DISTRIBUTION

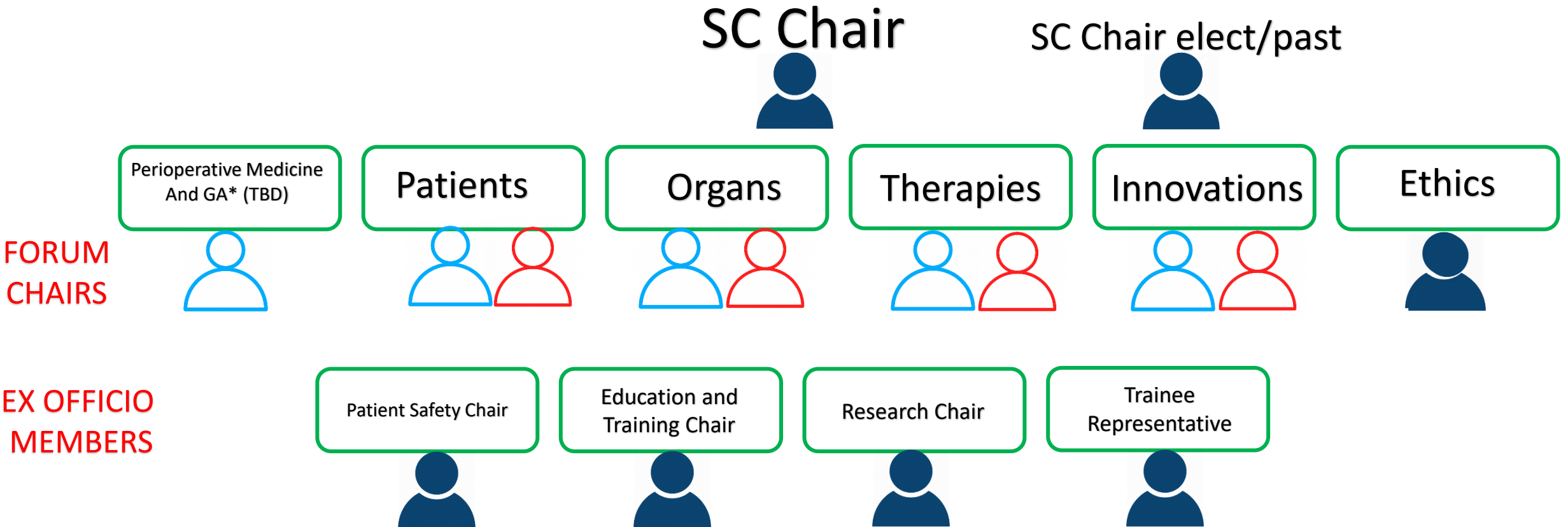
